TWO Agencies new to RSVP!

Metro South Chamber of Commerce—If you have excellent communications skills, are upbeat, friendly and are motivated, active and engaged, Metro South is looking for you to fill their **Administrative Volunteer & Internship Mentor** position in their Brockton office. This person will support Chamber staff by assisting with day-to-day office functions such as member services, the travel group, educational workshops, meetings and special events. Help is needed weekdays from 9 am to 2 pm.

Emeritus at Plymouth Beach—This assisted living complex is seeking **weekend visitor-volunteers** to socialize with residents either one-on-one or in small groups. Under the direction of the Life Enrichment Director, the volunteer/s may also assist with recreation programs to help provide, “a supportive environment to promote the health, independence and social interaction of seniors.” Hours are flexible.

Horizons for Homeless Children—Needs **Playspace Activity Leaders** to work with homeless children in area shelters. Leaders provide the nurturing, stimulation and opportunities for early education and play that all children need in order to learn and grow in healthy ways. Volunteers should possess a strong interest in preschool and school age children; be patient, dependable and sensitive to homeless issues. They must participate in a 6-hour training and be able to commit to volunteering 2 hours per week for 6 months. Additional training may be required at some programs.

Mt. Moriah Baptist Church, Brockton, Food Pantry serving approximately 35 families needs more hands to assist with shelving, packaging, screening and assisting customers at the bi-monthly distribution. A helper sensitive to the needs of low income people will complete or update the client in-take form with each recipient as needed. The distribution is held on the last two Saturdays of the month from 9 am to noon. This pantry is facing a 20% increase in requests!

Mass Correctional Institute, Plymouth - Minimum security facility, camp setting, houses 150 pre-release inmates in programs for reintegration into society. **Math and Literacy tutoring; art classes; book discussions; Toastmaster Gavel Club; facilitators for cognitive skills workshop.** Help needed for motivated young men. Attention residents of Hull, Hingham and Scituate!! Meals on wheels **Drivers Needed!** South Shore Elder Services is in need of drivers to transport meals to homebound seniors in the towns of Hull, Hingham, and Scituate. Weekdays from 10:30 to 11:30am. Short routes and paid route mileage. Great Need!

Whale & Dolphin Conservation Society's North American office located in Plymouth; rub elbows with biologists & international students working to protect the marine mam-

mals off our shores. Volunteers are needed for **data entry**, from **administrative needs to whale sightings data** or join a “mailing party”, where everyone pitches in to **stuff envelopes & chat**. Help biologists educate the next generation at local schools by **assisting with visual display presentations**, and perhaps learning to give presentations on your own. Help staff the WDCS booth at sites such as the New England Aquarium and New Bedford Whaling Museum, as well as summer wildlife festivals.

Plymouth Center for the Arts, North Street, Plymouth, is in need of volunteers to **welcome gallery visitors** - especially for the Saturday or Sunday shifts. Volunteering can be once or twice a month or weekly if desired.

Habitat for Humanity

Habitat for Humanity is working to eliminate poverty, housing and homelessness from the world by building houses for those in need. Their Family Support Committee is in need of a “**Family Partner**”. This group helps select the families who receive the homes. The Family Partner introduces the family to the Habitat organization and offers support to the family during the home-build process. Duties are varied and can include helping track the families volunteer hours during the build of their home; helping them develop good budgeting habits as they take on the role of “homeowner” and other issues that arise during the process.

South Shore Housing/HallKeen Management: A dedicated, caring, responsible person is needed to bring 16 Marshfield seniors their Brown Bag lunches on the 3rd Thursday of the month. The volunteer picks up the prepared lunches in Brockton for a noon delivery to the Marshfield community room.
